Prayer Partners

Medicines & Vaccinations

I strongly recommend that you go to the link, <http://mdtravelhealth.com/destinations/africa/uganda.php> to find valuable information about your trip and the area where you are going. There are certain vaccinations & medicines that are recommended for this trip. Some vaccinations should be taken some time before you leave. This web site will also give you common sense tips about safety, food, water and general wise traveling practices.

Malaria prevention medicine is a MUST on this trip. You will also want a prescription traveler's diarrhea medicine such as ciprofloxacin or levofloxacin.

You may get your vaccinations and prescriptions from different places such as; your doctor, your local health clinic or Passport Health. <http://www.passporthealthusa.com/> Some health insurance policies will cover these shots, it is worth checking into your policy.

Traveler's Insurance

We do purchase traveler's insurance for you as part of your trip. You will receive an email from the insurance company with your ID card and policy #. Make two copies of it and leave one with your emergency contact person and take one to Uganda with you. *It is your individual responsibility to familiarize yourself with your policy, what it covers and what it does not cover.*

What should I pack?

Here is a suggested list of things that you may want to include in your packing:

- Bible
- Personal journal
- Note tablets, pens
- Towel/washcloth
- coat hangers(to hang your nicer clothes)
- Soap
- Electric transformer(service there is 220 instead of our 110 here)
- 220 volt Power strip(can purchase one there for about \$6.00)
- Mosquito repellent

- Sunscreen
- Tylenol PM or sleeping pills
- Flip flops/slippers to wear around your room and hotel
- Sunglasses
- Medications
- tooth brush/ paste
- roll of toilet paper
- small packages of tissues
- Hand sanitizer
- other....
- **CASH TO BRING FOR PERSONAL SHOPPING:** You need to bring 1 or 2 brand new "looks unused" \$100 dollar bills for personal shopping. The Ugandan money exchange for the schillings are pretty strict on OUR US money condition.

Dress: Men usually do not wear shorts there, women usually wear dresses there. They dress very nice for church. Bring some nice dress clothes for church, and if you will be involved in any of the following: leadership training, crusades, teaching or preaching. Bring casual clothes for other times. You can have laundry washed at the hotel where you will be staying for about .25 per pc. of clothing.

We ask that you pack as lightly as you can so that space in your suitcases can be used to transport must needed materials and supplies for the mission. You will be allowed two checked bags and one carry on plus one personal item (like a small handbag.....)

***** Money (MISSION TRIP PAYMENTS):** trips are generally divided into 2 separate payments:

Payment 1 due: \$1200.00 due date NOVEMBER 18, 2016.

Payment 2 due: \$1300.00 due date DECEMBER 31, 2016 or sooner if possible.

Payment for the safari (if you are going) is \$600.00 and also due DECEMBER 31, 2016 or sooner if possible.
Reminder: the safari is at your personal expense.

Please send it in before due dates if you have it. We will be buying ministry supplies for the mission.
